THE MARBLE ARCH BLOOD BANK 1973

Part 3. By Susan Stone

The Chief Rabbi gave us special permission to write and work through Shabbat and Succot.

At one point a volunteer remembers Rabbi Unterman coming downstairs after the service with a tray full of coffee cups containing brandy and whiskey. All the time food and drink had to be provided for the workers. Victor Schaverein and the Sobell's opened up their kitchens, with the Ladies Guild and volunteers helping tirelessly.

At both centres, London's Jewish taxi drivers were magnificent. Queuing outside ready to pick up equipment, take people home, bring in donors from other areas and most importantly accompanying the refrigerated vans as a protection guard carrying the blood to the airport for transport to Israel by EL AL.

When it was all over 10,000 pints of blood had arrived in Israel.

*A telegram was received from Stanley Balfour –Lynn which read
"To Rabbi Unterman
From Stanley Balfour –Lynn*

I am part of a team of plastic surgeons operating round the clock in the burns unit at the Tel Hashomer military hospital.

What I have seen I will never be able to erase from my mind.

The patients, most of them boys never complain and try to keep us cheerful as we try to hide our sadness.

This morning at 3:00am as four of us worked on a boy with 80% burns but still miraculously alive after 1 week, I noticed that the blood running into him, keeping him alive, was from a batch that came from the Marble Arch Synagogue and that is what prompted me to send this cable.

My patients make me feel very humble.

Stanley Balfour Lynn."
