### **KNOCK KNOCK – JEWISH WOMEN'S WEEK CALLING** **3 – 10 May 2009**

Jewish Women's Week is powered by over 1,500 voluntary collectors and is the only Home Office authorised door-to-door collection in the UK Jewish community. This face-to-face approach brings a personal element to the appeal, making it WIZO.uk's largest annual campaign.

Unlike a postal campaign letter, you can't put our collector in the bin but it is still all too easy to ignore the fact that large numbers of Israelis live in fear, below the poverty line and are exposed to domestic violence and abuse. We are clearly unable to reach everybody who needs us at the moment but our collectors will be knocking on doors between 3 – 10 May this year to ask for your help in achieving this.

Times are tough for everyone right now but the economic crisis is having a damaging knock-on effect on our fundraising. Donations given during past Jewish Women's Week campaigns have enabled WIZO to provide essential services for thousands of these women, children and young people - often the weakest and most at risk members of Israeli society. As one of the largest social welfare organisations in partnership with the Israeli government, WIZO cares for people of every age, race and religion.

This year we are particularly looking to raise funds to provide vital services at our shelters for abused women, our centres for the prevention and treatment of domestic violence and our homes for children at high risk.
