The film depicts the attitudes and circumstances leading up to the outbreak of brutal violence, the intertwining stories of people struggling to survive the Rwandan genocide of 1994, and the aftermath as the people try to find justice and reconciliation. The genocide Museum in Kigali shows the horrors of this genocide, plus other ethnic cleansing atrocities that have gone before and the Holocaust, 2010 being the 65th year since the liberation of Auschwitz.
