A MAN OF MANY PARTS

We were all very sorry a couple of weeks ago to receive the resignation of our Treasurer Henry Edjelbaum. In the three and a half years that he had been in office he had worked wonders on our finances and general organisation. For the time being, under his help and guidance one of our Wardens Stanley Simmonds has assumed the temporary mantle, but this is only until the AGM in June.

There is however an interesting story about Henry's recent activities. Amongst his many other interests he holds the post of Vice Chairman of Magan Dovid Adom UK, and with characteristic devotion he has worked relentlessly for that wonderful organisation.

He was present last Thursday at a ceremony at the Frankfurt Jewish Museum culminating a formidable and dedicated chapter of activity when he represented MDA in the hand over by them of a Matisse worth £200,000 to that Museum. That sum of money paid to MDA for this to be done was given by the BHF Bank in Frankfurt.

The painting had been confiscated by the Nazis in the 1930's from its then owner who lived in Frankfurt and had been presented to the MDA by the lady to whom it had eventually been bequeathed

The painting, "The Pink Wall" was originally owned by a collector called Harry Fuld who lived in Frankfurt, his entire art collection was stolen but he escaped to the UK. The Matisse came into the hands of an SS Officer and in 1948 his widow when interrogated lead investigators to its discovery in a cache near her home. It then was transferred to the Musee Nationaux in Paris and formed part of a collection of items believed stolen by the Nazis. Fuld died in 1963 and left his estate to his housekeeper, Gisela Martin, and she in turn bequeathed her estate to Magan David Adam who consulted a reputable firm of solicitors in Germany specialising in restitution claims.

Henry justified the MDA motivation " that the bequest of Gisella Martin and the estate of Harry Fuld be put to the use no doubt intended, namely to allow MDA to save even more lives in Israel and elsewhere", but this legacy is only a small drop in the ocean of MDA's annual fund raising requirements.
