Teach them well and let them lead the way... At the heart of every community are our children and at Western Marble Arch over the past year we have been developing programs specifically designed for our younger members. It may surprise you but WMA does have many young families with small children and a great number of young professionals living in and around the West End. However we cannot be complacent.

We have already started to make a move in the right direction. We have held several successful Friday night dinners, both for students and young professionals. Alan Lee and Harold Pasha have successfully started a bi-weekly young person's Minyan in conjunction with Ari Cohen. For children we had a fantastic High Holidays programme which catered for more than 60 children. This was followed up with two jam packed parties for Chanukah and then Purim. I am sure there are not many Synagogues in Central London who entertain their children with Jugglers, Magicians and disco parties while still incorporating a strong Jewish message. Consequently the attendance at the Cheder is on the way up, thanks to the great work of Miriam Kaye and Rabbi Lionel. We have also started a mothers and baby group which is well attended each week and is a great chance for young mothers to meet.

We have proved that there is a demand for events catered for young people. However this is only the beginning. We need more young people on the board who are willing to drive these projects forward. We also need people to help with every age group, there is room for everybody. Just find a project that interests you, whether it be building our Cheder, to starting a Shabbat toddler or children's service. We plan to start hosting Friday Night Dinners for families as well as continuing with the student and young professional's dinners. You can help by getting a speaker for an event or by forwarding event details to people you know. If you have a new idea for WMA but don't have the time to put it into action, let us know. All of the programmes we started over the past year started with a small idea and there are plenty of people in the community with the determination to make things happen.

We would like to make WMA the place for all ages. This is not an impossible task, with the right people, motivation, foresight and imagination, this can be achieved. Together let's make it happen.
