"A GREAT YORKSHIREMAN"

If you look to the right of this article you will see that today's Kiddush is partly sponsored by the Ziff family to commemorate the Yahrzeit of the late Arnold Ziff. Let me declare an interest, Arnold was a friend of mine, a man whom I had known and respected for many years and who, together with his family were firmly inscribed with the utmost respect into the annals of the Jewish and Yorkshire Community.

The lesson that even the busiest people can make time for the small courtesies of life was one that he put into practice throughout his years.

The help which his own forbears had received when they arrived in this country from the Leeds Board of Guardians remained in his mind and he eventually succeeded his own father, Max, as President of that body.

He became Chairman of the Leeds Jewish Housing Association, which developed a beautiful estate of sheltered accommodation. "Loneliness is the scourge of the elderly" he said and he set about providing cultural, music and art classes together with a delightful restaurant for those who lived there.

He was a great lover of Israel from its very beginning, became President of the JPA and helped the Israeli economy in practical terms by importing shoes from their fledgling industry. He would insist that money he raised was devoted to meeting people's needs rather than on administration.

He held strong opinions, he did not agree with "the Wall" but his support in other fields was manifest.

He became High Sheriff of West Yorkshire, was on the Council of the University of Leeds to which he gave a Business School, and a Grand Steinway Piano. He restructured the Canal Gardens and provided an Orchid House to Roundhay Park. He made substantial gifts to hospitals as long as there was no publicity.

As member of a Medical Research Trust he was invited to visit Israel to see a new Body Scanner, he went over, arranged the funding for one for a Leeds Hospital to be used by everybody free of charge. One of the first of many such machines which have saved thousands of lives.

He provided the second prize for the Leeds Piano Competition organised by Dame Fanny Waterman ("Desert Island Discs" this week), provided an Indoor Cricket School for Headingley, an Art Gallery, funding for Leeds Parish Church, and the funds to transfer the Royal Armoury to Leeds.

By coincidence last weekend I was in Leeds, at a function held in "The Arnold and Marjorie Ziff Centre" a beautiful structure, which would accommodate 300 people for a function, provide rooms for exhibitions, for meetings, with restaurant facilities and a library. I couldn't help reflecting how nice it would be if someone in this area would provide just such a facility in W1.

We thank the Ziff family for today's Kiddush, in particular Michael Ziff, a member of this community who like his father is so generous, and gives so much often in a quiet, unpublicised way, and we wish him good luck for his sponsored run for Nightingale next week.
