**A TEACH-IN FOR YOMTOV: WHAT HAPPENS IN THE KITCHEN WHEN ROSH HASHANAH PRECEDES SHABBAT?**

All over the Jewish World tomorrow, extra eggs will be hard-boiled as part of an ancient tradition which allows us to prepare meals for Shabbat on the holy days of Rosh Hashanah that immediately precede it. It's called making an **Eruv Tavshilin**.

What is it all about? Well, we know that cooking on a Yom Tov for Yom Tov is permitted, but cooking ahead for other days of the week is not. This poses a problem when the second day of Yom Tov falls the day before Shabbat, as this year when the 2nd Day of Rosh Hashanah falls this Friday September 10, followed immediately on by Shabbat Shuvah. So, to allow us to prepare ahead on Yom Tov for Shabbat (when we absolutely cannot do any cooking), we employ a rabbinical formula known as "*Eruv Tavshilin*". These two words mean "a Mixture (Eruv), of Cooked Foods" (Tavshilin).

**How to prepare an Eruv Tavshilin:**

1. On Wednesday, before Yom Tov comes in, make up a plate consisting of a hard-boiled egg or some fish, or if you prefer, cooked meat, together with a challah roll; this will be kept for Shabbat.

2. Recite the following blessing:  
*Baruch Ata Ado...Eloh-einu Melech Ha'olam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav v'tzivanu al mitzvat Eruv.*

"Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the Universe, who has made us holy through His commandments, and has commanded us about the mitzvah of Eruv."

3. Make the following declaration:  
*"By virtue of this Eruv we shall be permitted to bake, cook, keep food warm, carry, light candles and to prepare and do on the Festival all that is necessary for the Shabbat."*

So now it is considered as if we had begun meal preparations for the Sabbath before Yomtov came in, and we can now continue on the 2nd day of Rosh Hashanah - Friday - to make whatever preparations we need for Shabbat .

N.B. Just remember to eat on Shabbat from the plate you prepared!

Wishing you all a *K'Tivah VaChatimah Tovah* - may we all be inscribed and sealed in the Book of Life.
