Operation Winter Survival

Last year at this time I asked if we at Western Marble Arch could support World Jewish Relief's **Operation Winter Survival (OWS)**, providing warm clothing and bedding to send to vulnerable Jewish individuals and families in the former Soviet Union, through the bitter winter. It is often the most vulnerable in the communities - the elderly and children - who suffer the most; difficult decisions have to be made every day as to whether to heat their home or buy food or medicines. Items such as warm winter clothing are luxuries they just cannot afford.

I was overwhelmed by the generosity of our members and those of the West End Great and their incredible response last year. This Gifts-in-Kind initiative, to collect essential goods needed to help the communities through the bitter winter months, inspired us at Western Marble Arch to donate the items requested in force.

With another gruelling winter on the horizon, I am appealing to you again to go through your cupboards and find items that can help support our Jewish families in Eastern Europe, where temperatures can plummet down to minus 20 degrees. Impoverished families need all the help they can get to survive the freezing temperatures.

This year, WJR's campaign is for **NEW OR NEARLY NEW HATS, GLOVES AND SCARVES**, as well as the funds to ship them out to as many communities and individuals in need as possible. So if you do not have any of the above articles to give us, please bear in mind that just £50 will pay for 10 boxes of essential supplies to be shipped to families in grave need.

Once again, therefore, we will be collecting warm winter items at Western Marble Arch and you can leave them as soon as possible with Oded or Maureen at the Shul (not on Shabbat of course!).
